**REQUEST FOR MR KAMAL FOROUGHİ TO BE GIVEN CLEMENCY & MEDICAL TREATMENT**

**Your Excellencies,**

We are the daughter, son and granddaughters of Mr Kamal Foroughi. We are writing this letter to request clemency for Mr Foroughi as he is very old and has no relatives in Iran, and to express strong concern about his health. This follows a 216,924 signatory petition requesting clemency, delivered to you on 1 September via the Iranian embassy London.

Mr Foroughi has just turned 77 years old (date of birth 3 September 1939) and is proud to be an Iranian citizen. He was born and brought up in Isfahan and worked in Tehran. He is also a United Kingdom (UK) citizen as a result of his first marriage. For many years he has been living between Iran and UK.

Unfortunately, on 5 May 2011 Mr Foroughi was taken into custody and has been held since then in Evin Prison. Mr Foroughi had a clean record at the time of his arrest, has served five years four months of his sentence and has behaved well in Evin Prison. We all live in UK and have not seen our father and grandfather for almost five and a half years.

We are worried that if our father and grandfather is not considered for clemency, he will die in prison a lonely old man.

We are very worried about our father and grandfather's health. It has just been confirmed that he has cataracts and requires an urgent operation in each eye to avoid blindness. Of course, if he was released from Evin prison he would be able to have his operations quickly with much less risk of subsequent infections.

In the name of God and humanity, we humbly request the Supreme Leader and President and Head of Judiciary of the Islamic Republic of Iran allow Mr Foroughi to be given clemency on compassionate grounds. Please let Mr Foroughi live the rest of his life in peace and quiet with us his family, where we can look after him.
